COHO, COHO, COHO, COHO

YES! They are here and in abundance. The schools are thick from Outer Black Rock to the Inner Pins just outside of Rosa Harbour all the way into Centre Island.

Average size is 16 pounds with 20 pounders on the dock daily. Limits are now 4 per day with a possession of 8. Eight 16 pound Coho is a lot of fish!!! Largest Coho to date 26.5 pounds!

Most anglers are using lures or anchovies. Anything silver or glow is working both in teaser heads and lures. Depths are 40 feet and up with speeds 2.5 to 3 mph

The weather at this writing is warm with FLAT seas. Yes flat seas means that a few boats are going out to chase hali. Those who do are getting limits daily – 2 per person
